Alef-Bet

Become acquainted with the letters of the Hebrew alef-bet and practice writing them. You will learn their names and pronunciation later. First you will see the letter as printed in books (including biblical texts). Next to that you will see a typical modern cursive Hebrew example. In your work you will be writing Hebrew often and if you wish to write more quickly and plan to study modern Hebrew, I suggest you try writing in cursive. You can also choose to write in a "stick" version of the printed Hebrew; but plan to learn both forms of the letters! This is not all of the letter forms. There's a few more to come.
